

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Sagaponack will hold a public hearing on the 10th day of July, 2017, at 3:00 P.M., at the Village Hall, 3175 Montauk Highway, Sagaponack, New York, to consider the adoption of a Local Law as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2017

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING VILLAGE CODE § 79-3(e) (1)
TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR FILMING**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAGAPONACK AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to recognize the level of activity including municipals costs associated with filming using public property.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF VILLAGE CODE § 79-3(E) (1).

Village Code § 79-3(E) (1) is amended to read as follows:*

- E. Permit fee. The Village Clerk shall calculate the permit fee required to be paid by an approved applicant as follows:
 - (1) Principal photography fee. [~~Five hundred~~] Five thousand dollars per day shall be paid for each day or part thereof covered by the permit, [except for special location circumstances described as follows: for the use of the Historic District of Sagg Main Street as a traveling and/or trucking shot, the fee shall be not less than \$2,500 per day] and \$1,000 per day or part thereof for each additional day except in the Historic District of Main Street where each

additional day shall require a fee of \$2,500 each day or part thereof.

- (2) Cleanup deposit. A separate certified check in the amount of \$500 for each day covered by the permit shall be paid pursuant to § 79-5 below.
- (3) Traffic control fee. One thousand dollars shall be paid for each day covered by the permit if the Chief of Police, or his designee, requires payment of the traffic control fee pursuant to § 79-4 below.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. SEQRA.

This is a Type II action under 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(20).

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

All persons in interest will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the public hearing to be held as aforesaid and may appear in person or by representative. The Village Hall is accessible to handicapped persons.
